OLD ST. STEPHENS CEMETERY -On private property, NE of present-day St. Stephens, Washington Co., AL Coordinates: 31°33.098N; 088°02.195W – BROWN, DOUGHERTY, FITTS, MAYHEW, RASER, ROBESON, VANPATTEN

The following memorial was found just to the north of the old cemetery. The monument is white marble, standing 12 to 14 feet tall and surrounded by a low stone wall. The coordinates are 31°33.321N and 088°02.337W. It reads, "In memory of Mrs. Caroline Medora, wife of Samuel Thompson Brown and daughter of the Hon. William Crawford, St. Stephens, Ala., born April 20, 1823, died April 29, 1841."

NOTE: The site of this memorial coordinates with the location of the residence of Judge William Crawford on the old 1841 map of the original St. Stephens.
