

Last Will and Testament of Frederick BAGWELL (1848)
Witnesses: Robert AVERY and G.L. HANCOK

I, Frederick BAGWELL of county of Fayette and State of Alabama do hereby make and publish my last will and testament and hereby Revoking and making void all former wills by me at any time here to fore made and first after my Decease that all my debts be paid out of my estate and Secondly that Christopher FISK have all of my goods and chattels (donds?) household and kitchen furniture farming utinsils horses cows hogs sheep and every thing else except what Shall here after be named upon the condition that he take care of my wife during her lifetime / all of the above named property Said FISK is to have the use of during her life time and after her death to be his own property with the exception of one flax wheel at the death of my wife is to be given to my Daughter Basheba MATTOX and one bed which is to be given to my granddaughter Polly WINTERS also a certain cott which is to be given to Frederick FISK the Son of Christopher FISK / in witness where of I Frederick BAGWELL the testator have to this my will written on one Sheet of paper set my hand and Seal this the 6th of January 1848.

BAGWELL, FREDERICK, a resident of Fayette County; private, particular service not shown; enrolled on August 20, 1835, under act of Congress of June 7, 1832, payment to date from March 4, 1831; annual allowance, \$50. Pension Book, State Branch Bank, Mobile. He resided in Fayette County, June 1, 1840, aged 80. Census of Pensioners, 1841, p. 148.
